
VIRGINIA HOMESCHOOL LAWS

FOUR OPTIONS AVAILABLE FOR HOME INSTRUCTION




Parents must comply with immunization requirements and maintain records at home according to \$22.1-271-4. Exemptions for religious or medical reasons are available.

Begin teaching. No testing required.

May register the following year for homeschool kindergarten or 1st grade.

*Refer to the "Virginia Law" section in the *Virginia Homeschool Manual* for more details. Membership in Home School Legal Defense (HSLDA) is suggested.


HOMESCHOOL STATUTE §22.1-254.1



Send the results of a test or evaluation to the division superintendent by Aug. 1 each year.

*DO NOT SUBMIT MORE INFORMATION THAN IS REQUIRED BY LAW.
When complying with the statute, HEAV encourages parents to use the least intrusive methods of compliance that are acceptable to your superintendent. The flow chart above describes several methods that have satisfied superintendents' requirements.

Submit test results, an evaluation, or portfolio to the division superintendent by August 1 each year.

*Testing requirements do not apply to children who are under the age of six as of Sept. 30 (§22.1-254.1(c))
